Port State Control. Port State Control (PSC) is the inspection of foreign ships in national ports to verify that the condition of the ship and its equipment comply with the requirements of international regulations and that the ship is manned and operated in compliance with these rules. Many of IMO's most important technical conventions contain provisions for ships to be inspected when they visit foreign ports to ensure that they meet IMO requirements.

Annex I and II are mandatory for all signatory nations to MARPOL while Annexes III, IV, V and VI are optional. Currently, the U.S. is signatory to Annexes I, II, III, V and VI. Annexes I, II, V and VI have been incorporated into U.S. law by the Act to Prevent Pollution from Ships (APPS) and implemented within 33 USC 1901 and 33 CFR 151.

A. PSC Directive inspection regime During each inspection of a ship initiated under the PSC Directive regime, the port State control inspector (PSCO), as a minimum, must check the inventory certificate s (IC) or a ready for recycling certificate (RfRC) or a statement of compliance (SoC) as applicable is kept on board and report this in THETIS.

A port State control visit on board a ship will normally start with, as a minimum and to the extent applicable, with an examination of the documents in accordance with Annex 10 of the Paris MOU Memorandum. In addition, the PSC Officer (PSCO) conducts a general inspection of several areas on board to verify that the overall condition of the ship complies with that required by the various Conventions.

Types of Inspection | Paris MoU

Port state Control inspections are carried out as per guidelines of IMO assembly resolution A.1190 (30) & ILO guidelines under Maritime Labour Convention 2006. Companies are required to understand the importance of maintaining vessels by keeping them manned with trained crew, well maintained equipment and machineries, adequately supplied stores and complied with MLC regulations in order to minimize the deficiencies.
